The escape room craze sweeping the world and its Hungarian roots

Today, there are thousands of room escape games across the globe from the US to China. But only few people know it all started in a cellar in Budapest. Escape room games are played in groups of up to five people who are locked in a room for an hour if they don't successfully escape before. In order to get out, they must work together to solve a sequence of puzzles, riddles and treasure hunts. "It isn't about who gets out first, or even if you get out in time," says Budapest local Attila Gyurkovics, the man who pioneered the concept. "It's about that hour spent, immersed in the game. Getting out successfully is just the icing on the cake."

"When the idea came into my head, I couldn't let go of it," says Gyurkovics. Within three months, he'd quit his job as social worker and opened ParaPark – his first room, Hungarian slang for "Park of Fear" – in a cellar underneath a run-down pub. "We just picked people in the bar above, and their reaction confirmed all we'd hoped," he says. "You see people after the game, and they're still talking about it for hours." For some, the escape room concept has become more than a game; it's a competitive sport. The first ever escape room world championship held its finals in Budapest in 2017. Teams of national champions from 22 countries attempted to break out of a room.

The phenomenal success is no surprise to Gyurkovics. From the first trial, he knew he was onto something. But Gyurkovics believes it's about the experience itself, not the location. "The main reason the games are so successful is the 'flow' experience," he says. He came across the psychological concept of "flow" in 2011. It describes a mental state of creativity and hyper-concentration. "Under 'flow', you lose that niggling feeling that you need to call home or you're hungry. You temporarily forget those worries," he says.

Now Budapest itself has about 80 escape rooms, hidden across the city in run-down bars, cellars and even private apartments. At around 10,000 HUF, about £30, per team, it's an affordable afternoon out for everybody.

Read the following article about *Mr Gorilla* and look at the statements.

An English policeman wearing a gorilla costume while crawling the London Marathon finally finished the race, almost a week after starting.

Metropolitan Police officer Tom Harrison, who goes by the name 'Mr Gorilla', raised a reported £26,000 for the Gorilla Organisation, which is dedicated to conserving gorillas in countries including Rwanda and Uganda.

The 41-year-old Londoner started the 42-kilometre route on Sunday and crossed the finish line the following Saturday.



- 10 Harrison slept at friends' houses in the evenings after completing around 10 to 12 hours and 7 kilometres per day. He swapped between crawling on his hands and knees and up on his hands and feet to save his blistered knees. Every 100 to 200 metres he needed to take a break. Last year, he was running the marathon for the first time. However, he was far less successful raising money since he ran the marathon in his costume as a 'normal runner' which drew much less attention.
- 15 Holding up a trophy and a toy gorilla, he ran over the finish line in central London this year flanked and celebrated by his two little sons.

When asked what advice he would give to others who might try to crawl the marathon, which he said has not been done before, Mr Harrison said: "I'd probably advise anyone else doing it to get a bit more training. We only did about four crawling sessions beforehand."


