Seven-year-old girl writes letter of complaint to Lego

Seven-year-old Charlotte Benjamin no longer likes to play with the girl Lego figures. In an angry letter to the company, Lego fan Charlotte listed all her complaints.

"I am 7 years old and I love Lego but I don't like that there are more Lego boy people and almost no Lego girls," she writes.



Charlotte is also bored of having to play with pink Lego and all the dull things that the girl Legos are left to do.

"Today I went to a store and saw Legos in two sections - the girls pink and the boys blue. All the girls did was sit at home, go to the beach, and shop, and they had no jobs, but the boys went on adventures, worked, saved people, and had jobs, even swam with sharks," she writes.

Charlotte's father, a 35-year-old teacher, sent the letter to the editor of a magazine, who posted it to social media. Many people agreed with her complaints on the Internet. The entry has already received 1,390 likes on Twitter and 4,107 likes on Facebook.

Many of the people who agree with Charlotte are mothers of young children with the same experiences. They come from places as far away as Hong Kong, Cape Town, and Chicago. The roles of the Lego boy and girl figures does not show what the real world is like, they say. It's time for Lego to make a change.

It's not the first time that the toy company Lego has been criticized for its boy/girl toys. As an answer to Charlotte's criticism, Lego has produced its first female lab scientist figure.



Not only Charlotte, but all other young girls who like climbing trees and playing football instead of playing quietly with dolls will be glad about this development.

Charlotte writes, "I want you to make more Lego girl people and let them go on adventures and have fun, okay?"

Yes, Lego, we think that you and other toy makers out there should produce more adventures for girls, too.

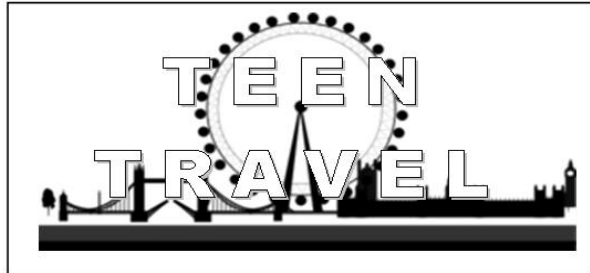
